"Expecting More: By Understanding How to Effectually Use Your Prayer Language"

One of the most controversial issues that has been a subject of much debate, argument, and separation has to do with the subject of 'speaking in other tongues'. Because we firmly believe as a corporate body in this supernatural communication, I will simply list a few scriptures for your individual study to help you understand the scriptural foundation for praying, speaking, decreeing, and releasing the power of God through your supernatural prayer language.

One of the first revelations that will help you understand how to effectually use your prayer language is I Corinthians 14:14:

"For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prayeth but my understanding is unfruitful."

Praying in other tongues is direct, accurate, and complete communication with God, and releases the mysteries of God through you that the Holy Spirit can reveal to you in any way that He desires to:

"For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries." I Corinthians 14:2

Your prayer language has the ability to move you into the plan and purpose that God has ordained for your life; and to direct your path even when you don't realize that you are being divinely led by the Spirit of God:

"Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

"And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

"And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are called according to his purpose." Romans 8:26-28

Your prayer language has the ability to build you up, edify you, release encouragement on your life, and move you out of depression, despair, or discouragement. It also activates the unconditional love of God in your life that keeps you from falling.

"But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost.

"Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life."

"Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy." Jude 20, 21, & 24th verses.

Set your faith to believe and expect that when you pray in other tongues that the atmosphere in the realm of the Spirit is assisting you to fulfill the perfect will of God. Your faith in the Word of God concerning this dimension will not only aid you now, but will also set the course for where God is taking you in your future.
