## Prophetic Insight for the Last Days

### “THE COMING OF THE SON OF MAN”

*“<sup>37</sup>As were the days of Noah, so will be the coming of the Son of Man. <sup>38</sup>For just as in those days before the flood they were eating and drinking, [men] marrying and [women] being given in marriage, until the [very] day when Noah went into the ark, <sup>39</sup>And they did not know or understand until the flood came and swept them all away—so will be the coming of the Son of Man.” {Matthew 24:37-39}*

*“<sup>30</sup>Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in the sky, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn and beat their breasts and lament in anguish, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory [in brilliancy and splendor]. <sup>31</sup>And He will send out His angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather His elect (His chosen ones) from the four winds, [even] from one end of the [universe to the other.” {Matthew 24:30-31}*

*“<sup>13</sup>I saw in the night visions, and behold, on the clouds of the heavens came One like a Son of man, and He came to the Ancient of Days and was presented before Him. <sup>14</sup>And there was given Him [the Messiah] dominion and glory and kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion which shall not pass away, and His kingdom is one which shall not be destroyed. {Daniel 7:13-14}*

*<sup>25</sup>And there will be signs in the sun and moon and stars; and upon the earth [there will be] distress (trouble and anguish) of nations in bewilderment and perplexity [without resources, left wanting, embarrassed, in doubt, not knowing which way to turn] at the roaring (the echo) of the tossing of the sea, <sup>26</sup>Men swooning away or expiring with fear and dread and apprehension and expectation of the things that are coming on the world; for the [very] powers of the heavens will be shaken and caused to totter. <sup>27</sup>And then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with great (transcendent and overwhelming)*

*power and [all His kingly] glory (majesty and splendor). <sup>28</sup>Now when these things begin to occur, look up and lift up your heads, because your redemption (deliverance) is drawing near.” {Luke 21:25-28}*

In this chapter, I’m going to help you understand how to receive revelation from the Word of God, by allowing the Holy Spirit to guide you in understanding what God’s Word is really saying. The first point I want to make is that you should make it a top priority to ask the Holy Spirit to guide you in the Word before reading it. He is the great teacher and guide as revealed in John 16 ***{read this chapter now}*** and if you will honor Him by depending on His guidance, you will see remarkable results.

In the scriptures outlined at the beginning of this chapter, the Holy Spirit gave me 7 revelations that will give us an understanding of the times we are now living in:

***THE DAYS OF NOAH***

***THE TRIBES OF THE EARTH***

***THE GATHERING OF THE ELECT***

***THE KINGDOM DOMINION AND GLORY***

***THE POWERS OF THE HEAVENS BEING SHAKEN***

***THE REDEMPTION OF GOD’S CHOSEN PEOPLE***

***THE ANCIENT OF DAYS’ SOVEREIGN RULE***

In each one of these headings, there is a pathway to understanding times, seasons, and prophetic revelation that will definitely come to pass. The first connection that the Holy Spirit gave me was to join the Old and New Testament together in order to receive the correct interpretation of what these scriptures really mean. The Word that reveals this principle is found in Matthew 13:52. Read it slowly and receive the impartation of the Holy Spirit.

Now that you see that you are the householder of the treasures that are under lock and key in both the Old and New Testament, you also need to know that only the Holy Spirit can unlock these great treasures that you have access to. One of the reasons that great error and deception has hindered the Kingdom Remnant Seed is because in many cases we have depended on the wisdom of men instead of the wisdom of God as Paul revealed to us I Corinthians 2:1-16. ***{Read these scriptures.}***

The Days of Noah give us a great understanding of the timing of God, the focus of mankind, the blindness of mankind, the failure to understand that a flood was coming, and the inability to be able to receive truth that would have spared them from being destroyed. The parallel to the days we are now living in cannot be denied no matter who you are and as we look at the scriptures both in the Old and New Testament, we see the following:

- \*\*\*\* The wickedness of man was great in the earth. {Genesis 6:5}
- \*\*\*\* The imagination of man was evil on a continual basis. {Genesis 6:5}
- \*\*\*\* God's heart was grieved to the point that He regretted that He had ever created mankind. {Genesis 6:6}
- \*\*\*\* God determined that He would release judgment on mankind and this judgment would be upon all creation. {Genesis 6:7}
- \*\*\*\* God releases grace to a remnant believer in the person of Noah and his family. {Genesis 6:8}
- \*\*\*\* God's grace was designed to rest upon a man that believed in justice, an example of wholeness to others, and one that walked with God. {Genesis 6:9}
- \*\*\*\* God found a man that would obey Him and follow His voice regardless of how crazy the instructions were, and how difficult the assignment would be. {Genesis 6:10-22}

There are several scriptures connected to Noah and his life that give us revelation of where we are right now as it relates to the timing of God, and they are:

***Ezekiel 14:14, II Peter 2:5, Isaiah 54:7-10, Hebrews 11:7, Genesis 9:18-19, Genesis 7:7-9, I Peter 3:20, Genesis 8:21-22, Genesis 9:8-9, Genesis 9:24-27, Luke 17:26-27.***

Your homework assignment is to take the headings and to allow the Holy Spirit to give you revelation of what they mean from the Old and New Testament. You are about to take the journey of your life. Enjoy yourself.
