1.	Living and operating with a debt mentality believing that it is Elohim's [God] way to living a prosperous life.
2.	Trusting and believing in your own natural ability to prosper and be successful, rather than trusting in the ability of Yahweh.  [LORD]
3.	Refusing to help others with your Kingdom Wealth, and having a low opinion and attitude towards those who are in need.

4.	Giving with a wrong attitude that is based more on what can I get than whom can I bless.
5.	Giving with the secret agenda of placing others under the spirit of control and obligation.
6.	Operating with a lazy, slothful spirit, and thinking that others are obligated to help me because I an entitled.
7.	Not operating in the spirit of wisdom and knowledge concerning Kingdom Wealth, because I make decisions without seeking Yahweh [LORD] first.
8.	Borrowing money and refusing to pay it back, and making excuses why I don't operate in integrity and honesty.
9.	Refusing to seek counsel and advice from those who are more knowledgeable of the Kingdom Wealth Economic System, due to walking in a spirit of pride.
10.	Failing to be a good steward over what Yahweh [LORD] has placed in my hands, and not being accountable in my financial dealings.

As we move into the Feasts of the Most High beginning with Passover, we will discover the power of what takes place when we call a Solemn Assembly as it relates to The Kingdom Wealth System:

\*\*\* Yahweh {LORD} will be jealous for His land. {Joel 2:18}

\*\*\* Yahweh {LORD} will send grain, new wine, oil, and full satisfaction.

{Joel 2:19}

- \*\*\* The Most High will remove the attack of the enemy's forces off our lives, and cause the enemy to flee. {Joel 2:20}
- \*\*\* Yahweh will do great things in our midst, removing fear, and releasing gladness and rejoicing. {Joel 2:21}
- \*\*\* Yahweh will send the former and latter rain, representing the double portion anointing. (Joel 2:23-24)
- \*\*\* Yahweh will restore what the enemy had stolen, and will deal wondrously with us, and will walk in the midst of us. {Joel 2:25-27} And will send a fresh outpouring of the Holy Ghost, verses 28-32.

"Sixteen years old was Uzziah when he began to reign, and he reigned fifty and two years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also was Jecoliah of Jerusalem. And he did that which was right in the sight of the Lord, according to all that his father Amaziah did. And he sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God: and as long as he sought the Lord, God made him to prosper." {II Chronicles 26:3-5}

Four of the greatest keys {there are several} that cause the Kingdom Remnant to prosper in the last days of the world's economic failure are found in these scriptures:

- \*\* Do what is right in the sight of Yahweh.
- \*\* Seek your Heavenly Father above anything and everything.
- \*\* Align yourself with those who have understanding of the visions of Elohim. {The word visions translated in the Hebrew is 'ra'ah', and it means: to see, behold, perceive, gaze, take heed, discern, to look on, to regard, and to hear clearly.}
- \*\* Resist the temptation to seek success and prosperity first, but rather seek your Heavenly Father first and His will, and "He will make you to prosper". {Also read what it says in Joshua 1:1-9.}

## LIVING UNDER THESE FOUR KINGDOM KEYS, WILL CAUSE YOU TO:

- 1. Be successful and triumphant in the realm of spiritual warfare, because you will receive help and be backed by your Heavenly Father. {see II Chronicles 26:6-7}
- 2. Receive Divine favor and blessings. Your Heavenly Father will enlarge your territory and expand your calling, because He will strengthen you exceedingly. {II Chronicles 26:8}
- 3. Be equipped with an anointing to build and provide resources where previously there were no resources, and to provide opportunities for those who had none so that their lives would be blessed. {II Chronicles 26:9-10}
- 4. Receive assistance and help from the corporate anointing to subdue, prevail, and conquer the enemy's forces; and to be triumphant in fulfilling the destiny and calling of our Heavenly Father. {Il Chronicles 26:11-13}
- 5. Receive an anointing for creative ideas and witty inventions that are outside 'the box' of the normal way of doing things, because your Heavenly Father will marvelously help you. {II Chronicles 26:14-15}

## **BUT THE STORY DOESN'T STOP HERE**

"But when he was strong, his heart was lifted up to his destruction: for he transgressed against the Lord his God, and went into the temple of the Lord to burn incense upon the altar of incense." {II Chronicles 26:16}

Unfortunately, as it is true in the lives of many of Elohim's children and leaders, the humble beginnings give way to a spirit of pride; an unteachable spirit; a spirit of control; intruding into areas that you have not been anointed for; and probably worst of all, a stubbornness and an unwillingness to admit when you are wrong.

All of these characteristics lead to one place: DESTRUCTION.

In Uzziah's life, instead of being the strength of Yahweh {that's what his name meant}, he became a leper which had the meaning of being unclean; cursed; outcast; rejected; shamed; and disgraced. The Spirit of Pride is one of the most destructive spirits that can enter a believer's life, and if not repented of and turned from will eventually lead to utter destruction.

In order the thrive in the Kingdom Wealth System, we must remain obedient; humble; sincere; grateful and thankful; have a teachable spirit and welcome correction when needed; and above all else continuously recognize that it is our Father that has blessed us to prosper and not we ourselves.
